**RULES**

1. Pre-entries are \$12.00 a class and are due by Wednesday before the show. Post entries are \$16.00. Six ribbons in each class, special prizes for the team winners and for the winners of Classes 9-11. We reserve the right to split or combine classes as entries warrant.
2. Britches, boots and USEF approved hardhats are required. Coats, braiding, etc. optional and are not encouraged. **(Come and have fun!)** For the Bareback Class you can wear chaps or jeans.
3. No schooling in the ring. The courses will be posted and available to walk before the show.
4. Negative Coggins Test within one year required at entry desk.
5. **MEDICAL ALERT-** The USEF has instituted a new rule concerning the vaccination for the Equine Influenza Virus and the Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis). Therefore, horses going to USEF as well as many other competitions are required to have proof of vaccination within six months for both of these viruses. AMIT is highly recommending but not requiring it for this year.
6. Refreshments will be available.
7. Seniors may ride ponies.
8. In case of poor weather, or for further information, call (301) 475-5434.
9. *By entering the activity, the Rider (and Guardian of the Rider) agrees not to hold A Moment in Time Shows, LLC, A Moment in Time Farm, LLC, their affiliates, employees, agents and/or volunteers responsible for any injury, loss or damage incurred. The Rider (and Guardian of the Rider) represents that he/she has the requisite training, coaching, and abilities to safely participate in this activity.*
10. It is recommended your horse/pony do no more than 5 canter classes.

**ORDER OF CLASSES AND CLASS DESCRIPTION**

In classes 1-8, the odd classes are to be judged by TABLE II - 2B. After an individual has successfully gone clean over their course (no refusals, run-outs, or jumps down), they remain in the ring. Once they receive the signal, they will immediately do their Jump-off, which will be judged first on going clean, and second on time.

In classes 1-8, the even classes are to be judged by TABLE II - 2C. After each individual has successfully completed their course, they will immediately cross the finish line and continue with the Jump-off course, which will be judged first on going clean, and second on time.

To enhance the fun we are allowing entrants to form teams. The teams will be made up of no more than four horse/pony/rider combinations. They will collect points based on their placing. The team with the highest total in Classes 1-8 will win a prize.

1. Flea-hoppers- open to all riders not wanting to canter. Jumps 12". Jumps must be trotted, cantering will be penalized. (Table II - 2b). Same horse/rider combination cannot jump over 18" at this show.
2. Flea-hoppers- open to all riders not wanting to canter. Jumps 12". Jumps must be trotted, cantering will be penalized. (Table II - 2c). Same horse/rider combination cannot jump over 18" at this show.
3. Cricket-Leapers - open to all. Jumps 18". (Table II - 2b). Same horse/rider combination cannot jump over 2' at this show.
4. Cricket-Leapers - open to all. Jumps 18". (Table II - 2c). Same horse/rider combination cannot jump over 2' at this show.
5. Pollywogs- open to all. Jumps 2'. (Table II - 2b).
6. Pollywogs- open to all. Jumps 2'. (Table II - 2c).
7. Flying Roaches- open to all. Jumps 2'6". (Table II - 2b).
8. Flying Roaches- open to all. Jumps 2'6". (Table II - 2c).

9. Take your own line- (Table III- faults converted to seconds, each fault= 1 second, 1 knockdown= 4 seconds)- you have to jump all the jumps in the ring once (and only once). The goal is to do it as quickly as possible. There will be a designated last fence you must jump prior to going over the finish line. Horses go 1<sup>st</sup> and jump 2'6, ponies jump 2<sup>nd</sup> and do 2'. **PRIZES!**
10. Rotating pair relay- (Table III- faults converted to seconds) Between you and your partner you must jump all the jumps in the ring once (and only once) as quickly as possible. You must designate which rider is the starter and which one the finisher. You may jump no more than 2 jumps in a row before your partner must do at least 1 jump. All to Jump 2'. **PRIZES!**
11. Bareback Jumper Stake- open to all. No saddles (pads are permitted), may wear jeans or chaps, no shorts!!! All to Jump 2', fastest time with a clean round. **PRIZES!**
