Entries for the divisions in this clinic are “open” (you may enter a division even if you would not qualify for the same division(s) at AMIT or other shows). Speak with your instructor to be sure you are ready for the division you wish to do. There will be approximately 7 riders per group. There will be a flat and an over fences class for each group. Before each class, the judge will explain to the riders and auditors what to look for. During the classes, the judge will judge each horse/rider. At the end, the judge will sum up the results and place the riders. Riders will receive a brief discussion on how to improve. There are no ribbons at this clinic!

There is a Foundation Equitation (for both assisted and unassisted) session in our Show Preparation Clinic. The division will occur during the lunch break (12:00-1:00). The group will be split as needed. AMIT instructors will judge and work with you. They will offer ideas on what to do to get ready for the upcoming show season.

PARENTS- THIS IS YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO HEAR FROM THE JUDGE. Anyone wanting to audit any group may do so at no charge! You may stand in with the Judge during the class or watch from the sidelines. Auditors should bring clipboard, paper and pencil to do your own judging and take notes on what the judge says.

RIDERS- if you are interested in participating in the clinic: fill out the entry form below and return by WEDNESDAY before the clinic. Cost of clinic is \$ 35.00 (IEA/IHSA-\$25.00) per division per day, \$20.00 for Foundation Riders.

ATTIRE- Show clothes are expected, but dress for the weather. No matter what, riders should be **NEAT** and must wear a hard hat, riding pants and boots with heels. **BE AT THE RING, WARMED UP, AND READY TO GO WHEN YOUR TIME BEGINS.** Space is limited. **YOU MUST PRE-ENTER TO BE GUARANTEED A PLACE.**
