As you may know, Linda Roe Miller, VMD, is planning another missionary trip with the Christian Veterinary Mission. These trips are designed to help people learn to care for their animals and improve livestock production. In addition they will provide education to the local veterinarians.

This is an expensive undertaking. Dr. Miller is responsible for raising the funds for her airfare, translators, transportation once there, food, supplies, and evacuation insurance. AMIT is doing our part by offering a special division at our End of Summer Show. All profits from this division will go towards her trip.

### A.M.I.T. BENEFIT ADULT ONLY (NOT THAT KIND!) DIVISION

Attire will be informal and low-key. Riders should be **NEAT**, and must wear a hard hat and footwear with heels. Jeans, regular shirt, etc. are permitted. Riders may show on horse or pony. \$10.00 per class. High Point rider will get a prize.

**Class A- Adult Pleasure-** Horses/ponies should have a reasonably loose rein, be able to stand quietly and back readily. Emphasis is on suitability as a pleasure mount. You will walk and trot as a group, canter will be brief and, depending on judge, may be individually done.

**Class B- Adult Equitation-** To be judged on rider's hands, seat, guidance, and control throughout. You will walk and trot as a group, canter will be brief and, depending on judge, may be individually done.

**Class C- Adult Jumper-** Table III (faults converted to seconds, each fault= 1 second, 1 knockdown= 4 seconds) meaning Fastest time wins. Riders will do a course of 4-6 jumps @ 12". Jumps can be trotted or cantered.
