RULES

1. Entries are \$10.00 per class if entered by the Wednesday before the show; post entries are \$14.00 per class. Pre-entries will receive a full refund of entry fees for any class(es) they cancel. Six ribbons in each class, champion and reserve in each division. Show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes as needed.
2. Show attire is optional. However, riders should be **NEAT** and must wear a USEF approved helmet, riding pants and boots with heels. Please **NOTE** that while a show may be labelled informal or schooling (meaning you are not penalized for less than a proper, traditional turn out) any rider who presents his/her animal and themselves with a proper, traditional turn out will create a better impression and thus get extra credit. Horses should be clean, clipped, manes pulled, and the tack clean. Braiding is optional
3. Ground conditions permitting, schooling will be allowed over fences from 5:00-5:45 a.m. and during the breaks (see schedule as to estimated times).
4. Negative Coggins test within one year required at entry desk.
5. **MEDICAL ALERT-** The USEF has a new rule concerning the vaccination for the Equine Influenza Virus and the Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis). Horses going to USEF as well as many other competitions are required to have proof of vaccination. The shot must have been given no sooner than 7 days prior, and no later than 180 days (6 months) prior to the competition. AMIT is highly recommending but not requiring it for this year.
6. Refreshments will be sold on the grounds.
7. Seniors (adults who are 18 and older as of January 1) may ride ponies.

DIVISIONS

ADULT GREEN RIDER— this is an equitation division open to ADULTS who do not wish to enter the regular divisions. Canter will be brief and may be 1 at a time. Jumps may be trotted or cantered. Jumps 12”.

ADULT PLEASURE- open to ADULTS only Jumps your choice 18” or 2’.

AD/JR GREEN HUNTER- open to horses and ponies in their first or second year cantering at a show. Same horse/rider combo may not enter Horse Hunter or Pony Hunter. Canter in flat class will be brief. Jumps may be trotted or cantered. Jumps 18” for ponies, 2’ for horses.

AD/JR LOW HUNTER - open to horse/rider or pony/rider combinations not wishing to enter the regular Hunter divisions. Canter in flat class will be brief. Jumps may be trotted or cantered. Jumps your choice 18” or 2’.

ADULT/JUNIOR HUNTER * * INCLUDES HUNTER DERBY * * - open to ADULTS and JUNIORS. The Hunter Derby Class has 2 rounds. The 1st Hunter Derby round will be inside the ring and judged as a classic Hunter round. The 2nd round may be inside and/or outside the ring and will be judged primarily on mount’s attitude and obedience. It will be a Handy course with test(s) such as roll backs, halts, walk or trot fences, open/close gates, and/or option jumps. Scores for the two rounds will be added together to determine the Derby placings. Jumps 2’ for ponies, 2’6” for horses.

ADULT/JUNIOR EQUITATION- open to ADULTS and JUNIORS. May not enter **JUNIOR LOW EQUITATION**. Division includes **JUMPING SEAT MEDAL** (which is judged on rider’s equitation, style, and technical merit over a jumper course. Penalties for knockdowns, run outs, or refusals.) Jumps 2’ for ponies; 2’6” for horses.

COMMAND, BREAK AND OUT— **special class** open to ADULTS and JUNIORS who have entered an Eq, Pleasure or Hunter Division. **Class is free** (but put it on your entry form), winner will receive a prize.

JUNIOR PLEASURE- open to JUNIORS. Jumps 2’ for horses, 18” for ponies.

JR LOW EQUITATION- open to JUNIOR riders not in **ADULT/JUNIOR EQUITATION**. Jumps 18”.

JUNIOR WALK/TROT- open to any JUNIOR who does not wish to canter. Same horse/pony/rider combo may not enter any other classes except Green Rider. Jumps 12”.

JUNIOR GREEN RIDER- open to JUNIORS not wishing to enter the regular divisions. This is an equitation division to "bridge the gap" between the walk/trot divisions and the canter divisions. Canter will be brief and may be 1 at a time. Jumps may be trotted or cantered. The same horse/pony/rider combo may not enter any other classes except Low Equitation or Walk/Trot. Jumps 12”.

FOUNDATION EQUITATION- Open to any rider. Judged 100% on rider’s position. Riders can have a helper (leader/sidewalker) in the ring. Riders in this division may not show in any other classes.
