



## A MOMENT IN TIME HUNTER PACE (25<sup>th</sup> YEAR)

Directions to AMIT- Across from St. Mary's County Fairgrounds turn on Route 244, go 2 miles and turn right on Breton Beach Rd, go 1.6 miles and turn left on dirt road, go 0.5 miles and turn right on driveway.

**DATE:** Sunday, October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020

**REGISTRATION:** 10:00 a.m.

**START:** To make it easier for riders to plan, we will have a time table of available starting times. The first team will start off at 10:30 a.m.; each successive team will leave at 5 minute intervals with the last at 12:00 p.m. If you have an approximate time you would like to start, please note that on your entry form. Arrangements can be made to ride before or after the 10:30-12:00 window - check with AMIT. Call Friday for your times, or check the AMIT Facebook page.

**DIVISIONS:** Senior flat, Senior O/F @ 2', Senior O/F @ 2'6", Senior O/F @ 3'.  
: Junior flat, Junior O/F @ 2', Junior O/F @ 2'6", Junior O/F @ 3'.

**REFRESHMENTS:** As much as we know everyone enjoys the social time afterwards for this year we are asking riders not to hang out (no offense, it is about the pandemic not you!). We will have box lunches available for you to take with you after the ride.

**AWARDS:** We will post the results on our website ([AMITFarm.net](http://AMITFarm.net)) and our Facebook page Sunday evening. You may stop by anytime the following week to pick up your ribbons.

The course will have a total of 15 jumps: 5 @ 2', 5 @ 2'6", 5 @ 3'. There will be a marker before or on the jumps telling the height. If you are doing a 2' division, you will jump just those 5 jumps, if doing a 2'6" division, do the 2' and 2'6" jumps (there will be 10 jumps total); the 3' division riders do all the jumps. Anybody can do any of the jumps - just be sure to do all the jumps in your division. **Please be careful of the footing, and watch out for holes, trash, and other unsafe items.**

### RULES

1. Entries for Juniors (16 and under) are \$25.00 per division if entered by the Wednesday before the Hunter Pace, post entries are \$30.00 per division. Entries for Seniors (over 16) are \$40.00 per division if entered by the Wednesday before the hunter pace, post entries are \$45.00 per division.  
*PLEASE MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO "LEONARDTOWN RESCUE SQUAD" (THIS IS A TAX DEDUCTION FOR YOU!!!)*
2. If you knock down a jump, you must reset it.
3. If you wish to pass other riders, you must warn them that you are going by and wait until they say it is OK to pass.
4. Divisions with less than 3 teams may be combined. Six ribbons in each division.
5. Hardhats, britches and boots are required at all times when mounted. Juniors must wear approved helmets.
6. Negative Coggins test within one year required at entry desk.
7. Refreshments (drinks and food) will be provided by AMIT and the Leonardtown Rescue Squad.
8. If the course cannot be ridden due to the weather, we will reschedule or try to arrange another day for it to be ridden as an unjudged exercise to all riders that have paid the entry fees. In case of poor weather or further questions, call (301) 475-5434.
9. *By entering the activity, the Rider (and Guardian of the Rider) agrees not to hold the Leonardtown Rescue Squad, Leonardtown Rescue Squad Auxiliary, A Moment in Time Shows, LLC, A Moment in Time Farm, LLC, and their affiliates, employees, agents and/or volunteers responsible for any injury, loss or damage incurred. The Rider (and Guardian of the Rider) represents that he/she has the requisite training, coaching, and abilities to safely be in this activity.*

You may compete in teams of up to 4 members. If your team is a Junior/Senior mix, you will be timed as a Senior group. The goal is to complete the course closest to the time that an average horse traveling at an average speed (a speed that could be maintained over a prolonged length of time) would do. This includes some walking, a lot of trotting and some cantering. The time will be determined by either a) averaging the times in all divisions or b) having a pace setter do the course and using that time as ideal. The teams closest to that time (over or under) will be the winners.
