Since this show is to help riders prepare for the County Fair we are having this show at the **St. Mary's County Fairgrounds**. The Fairgrounds are located on Route 5, 2 miles south of Leonardtown. From Route 2/4 travel south on Route 4 to its end. Turn left on Route 5. Go about 1 mile to the Fairgrounds on the left. Use the entrance by the FASTOP.

**RULES**

1. Entries are \$12.00 per class if entered by the Wednesday before the show; post entries are \$16.00 per class. Pre-entries will receive a full refund of entry fees for any class(es) they cancel. Six ribbons in each class, champion and reserve in each division.
2. USEF approved helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.
3. **In preparation for the Fair, all animals (EXCEPT Classes 1-12) should be braided. All riders should be in proper show attire.**
4. There will be Flat schooling ONLY in the ring between 7:30 - 8:15 a.m. and during the schooling breaks listed on the class schedule (at the Fair, you are allowed to walk only in the ring before the show and during the lunch break).
5. Negative Coggins test within one year required at entry desk.
6. **MEDICAL ALERT-** The USEF has a new rule concerning the vaccination for the Equine Influenza Virus and the Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis). Horses going to USEF as well as many other competitions are required to have proof of vaccination. The shot must have been given no sooner than 7 days prior, and no later than 180 days (6 months) prior to the competition. AMIT is highly recommending but not requiring it for this year.
7. Refreshments will be sold on the grounds.
8. Seniors may ride ponies.
9. In case of poor weather or further questions you can check our Facebook page or call (301) 475-5434.
10. Please **DO NOT** let your animal graze around the buildings or fences -- these areas may be sprayed with weed killer.

**DIVISIONS**

**FOUNDATION EQUITATION** - Open to any rider. Judged 100% on rider's position. All riders can have a helper in the ring and if need be can be led. Riders in either division may not show in any other classes. If entries warrant the division will be split Assisted and Unassisted.

**WALK/TROT** - open to riders on ponies/horses who do not wish to canter. The same horse/pony/rider combo may not enter any other classes except Green Rider. Courses to be trotted. Jumps 12".

**GREEN RIDER** - this is an Equitation Division designed to "bridge the gap" between the walk/trot divisions and the canter divisions. It is open to riders on horses or ponies. The same horse/pony/rider combo may not enter any other classes except Walk/Trot or Low Equitation. Canter will be brief and may be 1 at a time. Jumps may be trotted or cantered. Jumps 12".

**LOW EQUITATION** - open to riders on horses or ponies, riders cannot do the High Eq division. Jumps must be cantered. Jumps 18".

**PONY PLEASURE** - open to all ponies. Jumps 18".

**ADULT DIVISION** - open to riders 18 years or older on horses or ponies. Riders may not compete in any other division where jumps exceed 2'. Will consist of pleasure flat, a pattern, and a pleasure over fences round. Canter on the flat will be brief and may be individual. Jumps may be trotted or cantered. Jumps 18" or 2' choice.

**LOW HUNTER** - open to horse/rider or pony/rider combinations not wishing to enter the regular Hunter divisions. Same horse/rider combo may not enter Horse Hunter or Pony Hunter. Canter in flat class will be brief. Jumps may be trotted or cantered. Jumps 2' or 18"-your choice

**HORSE PLEASURE** - open to all horses. Jumps 2'.

**PONY HUNTER** - open to ponies. Jumps 2' or 2'6" -your choice. Heights may be restricted depending on footing.

**HIGH EQUITATION** - open to all riders except those in Green Rider or Low Equitation divisions. Jumps 2' or 2'6" for ponies; 2'6" or 3' for horses. Includes **JUMPING SEAT MEDAL** - open to all riders. Judged on rider's equitation, style, and technical merit over a jumper course. Penalties for going over the time limit and knockdowns, run outs, or refusals. Jumps 2' or 2'6" for ponies; 2'6" or 3' for horses.

**HORSE HUNTER** - open to horses. Jumps 2'6", 3' -your choice. Heights may be restricted depending on footing.

**\*NEW\* JUMPER DIVISION** - open to any riders on horses or ponies. All classes are TABLE II - 2B. After an individual has successfully gone clean over their course (no refusals, run-outs, or jumps down), they remain in the ring. Once they receive the signal, they will immediately do their Jump-off, which will be judged 1<sup>st</sup> on going clean, and 2<sup>nd</sup> on time. Includes a **GRAND PRIX (and if entries warrant, PRIZE MONEY!)**
